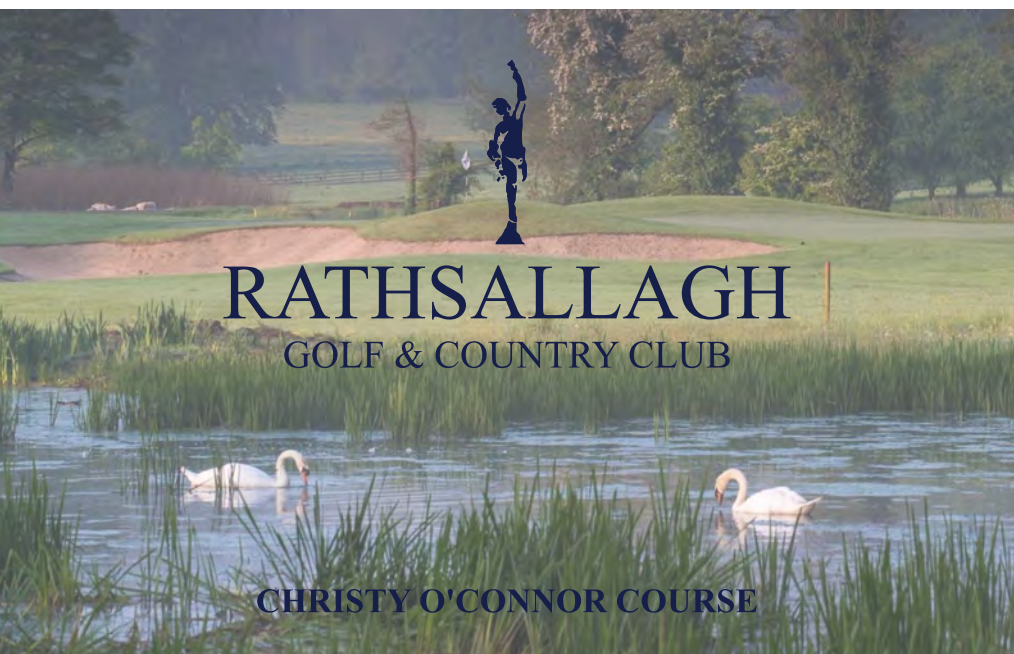

# Local Rules and Etiquette

## 1. Out of Bounds (Rule 18.1)

Beyond any course boundary or white markings. Where there are two boundary fences the inside fence defines the boundary.

## 2. Immovable Obstructions (Rule 16)

All road, pathways, staked trees, fixed sprinkler heads, fairway distance markers, permanent tee markers, seats, bins, ball washers are similarly defined. Relief is available under Rule 16.

## 3. Stones in Bunkers

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions (Rule 12.2a applies)

## 4. Embedded Ball

### (Specimen Local Rule 16.3a applies)

There is relief for ball embedded in its own pitch mark in the general area of the course as defined by Rule 2.

## 5. Red Penalty Area on 8th Hole

If you are aware that the only possible place that the ball can be, is in the Penalty Area on the right-hand side, which divides the 8th fairway, the player must continue to play another ball under the applicable rule option in 17.1d. If the ball is subsequently found outside the Penalty Area, the player must continue to play with it. If the original ball is found in the Penalty Area, the player may either play the original ball as it lies or continue to play under the applicable Rule option in 17.1d.

## 6. Additional Rules

### Please observe Golf Etiquette

If a group loses a hole on the group ahead it should give way to the next group. Repair pitch marks and divots with care. Rake all bunkers properly. The Golf Club dress code must be adhered to.
